



ADGA Bag Tag Rules



Everyone is on their honor to conduct themselves according to the rules and within the spirit of competition. Have fun. It's only a tag. The purpose of the Bag Tag Challenge is to encourage friendly competition among Abilene Disc Golf Association members.

Getting Started

Join the Abilene Disc Golf Association to receive a Bag Tag (supplies limited). All players must carry their Bag Tag at all times and it should be plainly visible.

The Goal

Your goal is to have the lowest numbered Bag Tag possible and have fun along the way.

The Rules

1. Members with a current Bag Tag may issue/schedule/participate in challenge(s).
2. Any member with a higher Bag Tag number may challenge any player with a lower Bag Tag number to a round of disc golf. Group challenges are ok if everyone agrees.
3. In order for the Bag Tag Challenge to work, all challenges must be accepted.
4. When a challenge has been accepted, neither player can participate in Casual challenges until the agreed upon match has taken place.
5. Members cannot avoid challenges by leaving the Bag Tag at home or by concealing their Bag.
6. The player receiving the challenge must make a "fair and reasonable" effort to be available to play.
7. Tags must be exchanged immediately following the round, lowest score gets lowest tag. In the event of a tie, the player who started with the lowest numbered Bag Tag will be awarded the lowest numbered Bag Tag.
8. If play is stopped during the round for a legitimate reason (weather, emergency, etc.), tags are not exchanged. Otherwise, if a defending player does not complete a challenge round, tags must be exchanged.
9. Automatic challenge is in effect during any League, Tournament, or Casual/Recreational rounds, if any ADGA Bag Tag holder(s) are on your card (in your group). The challenge does not need to be publicly announced or agreed upon before the start of the round—it is automatic! Members may not deny this challenge otherwise a forfeiture may occur. Players using different tees are competing against only other players using the same tee format.
10. Challengers who have just won, may, but do not have to immediately accept/schedule a rematch challenge from a player that the he/she has just beaten.

Forfeiture

Each Bag Tag belongs to the entire club membership and should be accessible to all club members. Any club member will be required to surrender his/her Bag Tag if:

- He/She is found to be purposely concealing the Bag Tag, especially with a low number.
- Refusing and/or "forgetting" to carry his/her Bag Tag, especially to events where members are "likely" to be present.
- Refusing Automatic Challenges.
- Generally denying Bag Tag access to other members (TBD by 2 or more board members).

If you lose your Bag Tag, please report it immediately. Replacement tags, if available, will cost \$10.00.

Rules are subject to change and the ADGA Board of Directors will decide all disputes. The ADGA Board of Directors reserves the right to revoke your Bag Tag at our discretion.
